- Possess knowledge of gymnastics skills and progressions and proper apparatus execution.

- Maintain accurate attendance and progress reports as required
- Respond appropriately and in a timely manner to participant and facility emergencies, including completion of accident/incident or minor injury log.
- Follow all Park District policies and procedures.
- Performs other Park District-related duties as assigned.

Education and/or Experience: Less than high school education; or up to one-month related experience or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Experience working with young children preferred.

Schedule: Evenings Monday-Thursday during the months of September - May. Occasional weekend hours are required during January-April for gymnastics meets.
